During 2015, we have focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our *Great Results Guarantee* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our strategies to ensure that every student succeeds.

Strategies implemented include:

- Increasing intervention support available to students in the early phase
- Reviewing student performance data regularly and implementing intervention programs based on the data
- Improving teacher capability through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance
- Providing extension opportunities (online IMPACT program) for U2B students in Yr 3 and 5
